Hello! It's with great excitement that we write you this month. The Holiday season was quite a whirlwind for us, as was kicking off the new semester here at U of I. We hope you've found life returning to normal - if that exists!

One aspect of our ministry that's the most exciting right now is our Learning Lab time. Each Monday night a group of 24 students have committed to being trained and equipped to be the next generation of students leaders. Most of these students are freshmen and sophomores eager to see God change this campus.

This past Monday we wrapped up a few weeks of training focused on The Bridge Diagram as a tool for sharing The Gospel. Next week we'll be brainstorming outreach ideas to engage the campus on questions of faith and Jesus. The week after we'll be discussing how to share our testimonies as a method of sharing about Jesus.

Each week we spend 1.5 hours training and dialoguing about how to do outreach and then assign homework. This week the 24 students accepted the assignment of sharing The Gospel through The Bridge Diagram with another student in the next 2 weeks.
